10) İRŞAD ( 11) JIHAD (CIHAD) 12) CAUSE (DAVA)

### 10) **İRŞAD**:

- → Means showing the right path to the people, warning their hearts and turning them towards the Truth, eliminating the obstacles that stand in front of people on their way to Allah, and help them meet Allah...
- → Every muslim is responsible and given the task of irshad and conveying the message according to his/her facilities and abilities, according to how much his/her possibilities permit. Yes every believer is responsible for explaining the Allah, Whom he/she put faith in, and His Messenger to all the people, helping the hearts who listen hear the message and love it, thoroughly represent the religion and show that in any condition and any situation the believer can live his/her religion to its full extent.
- → The one who fulfilled the responsibility of Irshad is called Murshid.

### 11) JİHAD:

- → The word Jihad means to try, to strive, to use all the strength given.
- → Jihad, depending on different conditions sometimes means to protect such values as life, property, religion, generation, motherland and honor; and sometimes it means the activity (which is addressed upon nesessity) of eliminating the obstacles on the way of elevating the Word of Allah.
- → It does not hold the same meaning as is imposed and explained by media and some publications nowadays.
- → There are two types of Jihad:
- 1) Great Jihad: The jihad and struggle agains one's own carnal soul (nefs).
- 2) Minor Jihad: Struggle, battle for the sake of protecting Islam.
- → "Fight and struggle, proclaim jihad on the Way of Allah. And know that without a doubt, Allah is a true All-Hearer and All-Knower" (Bakara 244)

## 12) CAUSE:

- → The word "Ideology" (mefkûre) holds within itself such meanings like aim, purpose, ideal and the imaginative intention; thus some prefer using the words ideal or imaginative intention, instead of ideology.
- → When a person personalises or owns a cause or a goal wholeheartedly; tries to assess his own actions, behavior and attitude, even the way he laughs or cries under the light and scrutiny of his goal, then his/her everything will follow his goal and his cause.
- → We can call those who carry this belief inside, the heroes of the cause: My life will have any significance only if I will talk about my God, If I will perform my own religion I will gain some mening to my existence.
- → One of the students of Said Nursi, Hamid Efendi from Van, talks about this event: Hazret Said Nursi, after visiting Grand National Assembly in Ankara leaves for Van. During the years that he stayed there, he used to climb the Van Castle that wa at the height of two minarets. Each time he visited the castle he would also descend to a cave that was situated at very steep and precipitous place. Once, when he was approaching the cave quite fast, his feet slept and he could not find anything to hold on to. Said Nursi was hanging in the air. Even at that moment he did not think of his life at all, he thought of his cause, his service to the religion and the nation. As loud as his voice allowed him, he cried: "Oh my cause, my cause!". The place where he fell is six meters deep cliff, but as if a hidden hand holds him, and pushes him, and he makes a three meters curve, lands at the entrance ofthe cave below him. This is the man of ideology, this is the man fo cause!
